This is a very old cemetery. Some of the graves date from the early 1800's & some of the people were born in the mid 1700's.

Many interesting people are buried in this grave yard, such as Archibald McDonald # 680, who is said to have been one of the first pioneers of Oregon, USA.

This graveyard is well looked after but the stones are very old and many are laying on the ground, are buried in the ground, as well as many which have parts cracked or missing. A few are so old that the writing has disappeared altogether. Every effort was made to accurately record as much as possible on every stone.

The recording was completed on April 28,1991.

#99 does indeed have more writing on it, but it is not "quite illegible". It read plain as day even from a full upright stance. Often what is illegible at one time of day is quite readable when the light falls at a different angle, or on a different day under different weather conditions. It reads: TO THE MEMORY/ OF/ THEODORE DAVIS, ESQR/ LAND SURVEYOR OF THE/ LOWER PROVINCE OF CANADA WHO DEPARTED THIS LIFE/ ON TUESDAY THE 16<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 1841/ AT HULL/ PROVINCE OF CANADA ON THE OTTAWA/ AGED 65 YEARS.

Gravestone transcriptions should ALWAYS be double-checked against the stones before being published, as some of the inevitable errors would be caught this way. Having found this many mistakes in a couple of hours I am very nervous about trusting the recording of the stones I did not check. Someone really should go over this publication on the ground stone by stone, aiming at a new and more accurate printed version. Researchers, especially at a distance, inevitably accept such recordings as accurate and complete when in fact this one is neither. This cemetery is of immense interest and merits a proper job. I only wish I had the time
